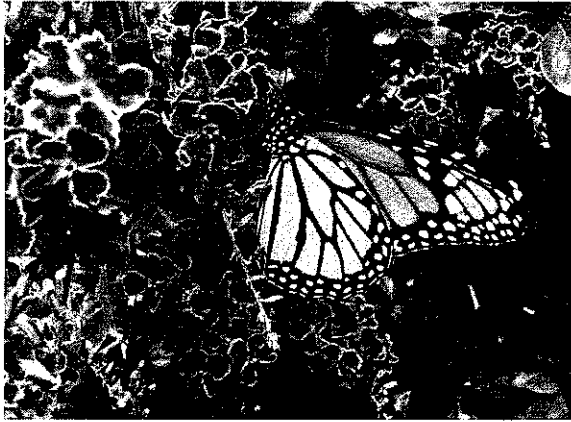


Who we are...
