

Remote Learning Expectations

It is our goal to assist you to the best of our ability to have a successful first semester of school. Learning remotely can prove to be challenging and we have created a list of expectations that may help to ease the transition from in person learning to remote. Please be mindful that there may be some technical issues along the way and we will work as quickly as we can to get you back on track.

- You are expected to attend your courses on a daily basis. This will help you establish a daily routine as well. You will be able to interact with your teacher during classroom time through a Google Classroom.
- You should be checking email daily for updates and/or announcements.
- You should be checking PowerSchool daily to see if you have been tagged by one of your teachers for academic support.
- Attendance will be taken every day/every period. If you are marked absent it will be recorded in PowerSchool and a phone call will be made to your parent/guardian. Make sure to set your alarm so you are up and prepared for your first class of the day.
- Complete all assignments and assessments on the day they are due. Grades will be awarded for work completed. This is different from this past spring when you received a mark of pass/fail instead of a numerical grade. There are no packets being sent out to work on at your own pace.
- You should create a space in your home where you can be focused during class time. We prefer that you sit at a table or desk rather than lying on your bed.
- You will need to be visually present in all of your classes. No memes or emojis will be acceptable.
- Your behavior should be the same as if you were sitting in the class on campus. When necessary the administrators will reach out to parents if your behavior is inappropriate.

If you find that you are unable to access your online learning forum due to a technology glitch please reach out to the high school tech team. For all other issues you are encouraged to contact your grade level administrator or school counselor.
