- 1. When is the first day of school for freshman? September 1st, 2021. The day is very laid back and provides us the opportunity to show you around our building.
- 2. What time do I have to be at school each day? The warning bell for first period will ring at 7:55am. Period 1 will begin at 8:00am. Please be in your classroom before your course begins.
- 3. What should I bring for supplies on the first day? We would suggest bringing a notebook and something to write with on the first day of school. Each of your teachers will let you know what is needed for their individual classes.
- 4. How does lunch work at the high school? At Messalonskee High School we have two separate lunches that run at the beginning and end of period 4. Your period 4 class will determine when your lunch takes place. We will continue to provide free lunch again this year for each student at MHS.
